Quilt Appraisal

- Appraising is assigning values that can be defended using factual data in a court of law, if necessary. Appraisals are prepared for sale, insurance, and donation purposes. Appraisers are required to know how to prepare donation appraisals that conform to Internal Revenue Service rules and regulations. Appraising is subject to rules and regulations established by the government and the recognized certifying body. One certifying body is the American Quilter's Society (AQS). Before being certified a person has to have a solid foundation in quilt history, styles, trends, fashion, and fabric. Before being tested for certification, a person usually has to have some experience with appraising. AQS also offers a three-day appraisal skills course in Paducah each April.

Quilt Patterns in Newspapers

- Do you remember when newspapers printed quilt patterns in their women's pages? The Kansas City Star was the first to do this in 1928. A quilt designer by the name of Ruby Short McKim was the first to supply the block patterns to the paper. They were free but later other papers did the same thing but charged for the patterns. The Kansas City Star ended the feature in 1961 but now runs a "block of the month" feature which started in 2000. If you are interested in the patterns you can go to www.pickledish.com and click on My Star Collection. For \$20.00 you can download one of the Kansas City Star quilt patterns once a week for a year.

Hoffman Challenge
