Project Ugly Quilt – Friday, July 19th from 3:30 to 4:30

# **Project Ugly Quilt Rules**

- 1. Six teams made up of 3 members each (cutter, sewer, presser), plus one alternate, from area quilt guilds are invited to compete at the Kaleidoscope of Quilts XVI show on Friday, July 19th from 3:30 until 4:30 at the Exhibition Center at Sylvania Tam-O-Shanter.
- 2. Each team will have 60 minutes in which to design and create a completed block measuring  $16-1/2 \times 16-1/2$  inches.
- 3. Each team must supply their own sewing machine (1), sewing supplies (cutting mat, rotary cutter, scissors, pins and thread, etc.), iron and ironing surface. Glitter of any kind will not be permitted!
- 4. Each team will be provided with a bag of fabric and embellishments. Included in the bag will be a piece of the "Ugly Fabric," that must be predominately featured in the completed block. Each block must reflect the quilt show theme "Sweet Sixteen."
- 5. Teams will be permitted to trade fabric and embellishments with other teams during the competition.
- 6. At the end of the competition, each team will walk their quilt block down the runway.
- 7. The deadline to register your guild's entry for the competition must be received by June 17<sup>th</sup>. If more than 6 guilds register to compete, each quilt guild's name will be placed in a hat and six names will be drawn. All guilds will be notified by June 24th whether or not they have been selected to compete in "Project Ugly Quilt".
- 8. Completed blocks will be combined and made into a quilt that will be donated to a local charity.

# Judging

- 1. The winning block will be "judged" by those attending the show. A jar will be provided for each of the participating guilds. Show attendees may vote for the best "Ugly Quilt Block" by depositing their spare change in the jar for guild's block that they like the best.
- 2. The "Ugly Blocks" will remain on display until the end of the show. Show attendees will have until 3:30 on Saturday to vote for their favorite "Ugly Block."
- 3. The guild with the highest level of change in their jar (not the actual dollar amount) will be declared the winner. The winning guild will be announced at the conclusion of the Style Show on Saturday.
- 4. The first place winner will receive a check for \$50 made out to the charity of their choice, a trophy, and bragging rights as the winner of "Project Ugly Quilt". The second place guild will receive a check for \$25 made out to the charity of their choice and a trophy.
- 5. The change in each guild's jar will be given to each of the perspective guilds to be used to support their programs for the up-coming year.
- 6. A representative from each of the participating guilds must be present at the conclusion of the style show on Saturday, July 20th at 4:30, to receive their change jar and possible trophy.
