The UFO Challenge for 2016 is to complete your oldest UFO. Bring in the oldest UFO you have stashed away, and commit to finishing it by January 2017. (Choose something you are willing to complete!)

Work Day, March 19

Our Spring work day will be Saturday, March 19, from 9:00-4:00, at the Bowling Green Community Center. Members can work on charity projects, or a project of their choice. Fabric and batting for donation quilts will be available. We usually order out for lunch, or you can bring your own. Hope to see everyone there!

It is Spring and the Round Robins are Coming!

Hope you have been thinking about which Round Robin you want to participate in in this year! March meeting will be the sign up and groups will be made.

Do you want to do the **Row-by-Row** quilt? You would be making 5 blocks each month. The quilt's owner choses the size of blocks from 6" to 12". The ideas for the quilt are endless. Let's see, baskets, summertime, Autumn, classic blocks, like log cabin, nine patch all in solids, or one color way, or what about a row by row quilt with cats and dogs!

Second is **The Vase Quilt**. You prepare a background with a vase and or basket. Each month it gets some flowers, and or leaves, or filler put into the vase. You could try some new techniques like ruching a rose, or yo-yo flowers, or molding petals with the new interfacing on the market. As the quilt owner, you could request that you want only roses, or only spring flowers, or if you are daring funky flowers!

The final choice would be a **traditional** Round Robin where you, the quilt owner, makes the middle medallion and then it is passed, for a round of border to be added. Again, it is your choice to decide a theme, and see what your fellow guild members come up with to bring your quilt to life.

Yes there is a commitment to your group to do your part, but each month your 'assignment' is small and in the end you will have a special quilt made by your guild friends.

In March will be sign up for groups. In April the Round Robin starts and the 'quilt is passed' for the first time.
