Fabric #2

6 squares $9\frac{3}{4}$ " x $9\frac{3}{4}$ " cut diagonally twice to yield 24 triangles (I)

2 squares $5\frac{1}{8}$ " x $5\frac{1}{8}$ " cut diagonally to yield 4 triangles (J)

Fabric #3

5 squares $9\frac{3}{4}$ " x $9\frac{3}{4}$ " cut diagonally twice to yield 20 triangles (I)

24 rectangles (K) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ "

Fabric #4

6 strips $2\frac{1}{4}$ " x 40" for binding

9 squares (L) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ "
