

Tiny Piecing Workshop by Lynn Harris

Lynn will show us how to piece tiny stars and other small blocks as well as small scale intuitive piecing and we will learn tips and tricks that make working small easier. With these tips we will be able to add a bit of tiny sparkle to our own quilt designs or make our own quilt completely from tiny blocks like the one the cover of Lynn's book Every Last Piece.

Materials Needed for class:

- * Sewing machine, quarter inch foot without attached guide, and if you have a single stitch throat plate that should be attached.
- * New 75 or 80 sewing machine needles for your machine
- * Extension cord/power strip
- * Thin thread such as Aurifil 50wt, DecoBob by Wonderfil threads, or Bottom Line etc
- * Rotary cutter, ruler, rotary cutting mat
- * A stiletto would be helpful
- * A variety of solid and small print scraps or other pieces, and several contrasting fat quarters
- * Basic sewing supplies – ie.: scissors, seam ripper, pins, etc

*In addition to the supplies on the list here, Lynn will have an **optional \$5 "kit"** of decobob prewound bobbins to try and precut one inch squares to play with. The decobob thread is a thin polyester but works well to reduce bulk in the seams which is helpful in tiny piecing. The precut squares help with accuracy in that the first step to getting accurate piecing is starting with accurate cutting. That step is done and ready for play. Scraps and small pieces are fine for this class. We will be making small parts and playing with different techniques.*
