How about a road trip with a quilt being the end result? Starting July 1st until September 2nd you can participate in the Row By Row Experience! Visit the participating shops and ask for their 'Row by Row Pattern.' No

passport is need. You can travel the USA and Canada shops to gather your rows! Each shop has designed a pattern especially for the hop to highlight a season, their state or shop. The shops may have a kit to go along with the pattern. Zebra Patterns has designed Auto License plates for each state that is participating that can be used in the quilt or for other projects if you like. Collect at least 8 rows. Sew them together in a finished quilt that is guilted, bound, and labeled and then be the first to return it to one of the participating shops before October 1st and you could win 25 fat quarters! If you use that shop's row in your quilt, win a bonus prize! We are in an area where many quilt shops are participating and it would be very easy to get the 8 rows.
