April Challenge

Make a birthday card for the Black Swamp Quilters Guild as we welcome our 30th year! Rules:

- -Must measure no larger than 17" on the longest side
- -Must include a Diamond Shape (30th Anniversary Symbol)
- -Any color combo is welcome
- -Any method of construction
- -Must be quilted with at least three layers (top, middle and bottom)
- -May be embellished, but not required
- -Must make an envelope for the card

Have fun! Be Creative! Some suggestions --- use your imagination. The card can be a single flat card (think postcard) or folded like a traditional card. It may have flaps, pop-ups...you decide!

Bring the completed card to the April 12, 2018 meeting in its own envelope and in a brown bag. The committee will open the cards and display them for voting.
